### TEACHER COMMENT

He has not progressed as well as expected in reading - we recently met to discuss how this might be addressed in Year 4 and look forward to supporting Liam with this.

### EXPLANATION

This progress report shows your child's progress throughout KS2. There is a report for reading, writing, GPS (grammar, punctuation and spelling) and maths. The maths grades are combined grades for both arithmetic and reasoning.

In each year group, pupils can be assessed as working at one of four levels:

**BYG** Working below expectations

**WTS** Working towards expectations

**EXS** Working in line with expectations

**GDS** Working above expectations

**Effort scores are provided in each subject. This score reflects your child's effort during the last term. Scores are between 1 and 5 (1 = very little effort; 5 = outstanding effort).**

### END OF KS2

In Year 6 (at the end of KS2), pupils sit national curriculum assessment tests for reading, GPS and maths. Writing is assessed by teachers using a national assessment framework.

Pupils can attain the following grades:

**WTS** Working towards the expected standard

**EXS** Working at the expected standard

**GDS** Working at greater depth

Different grades are used for pupils working below the expectations of the key stage.
