

TEXTILES: APRONS

Design, make and evaluate an apron (**product**) for ourselves (**user**) to use when baking or cooking (**purpose**).

Key Focus: 2D shape to 3D product



KEY KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS

- Know how to strengthen, stiffen and reinforce existing fabrics.
- Understand how to securely join two pieces of fabric together.
- Understand the need for patterns and seam allowances.
- Know and use technical vocabulary relevant to the project (e.g., fastening, compartment, strength, weakness, stiffening, templates, stitch, seam, seam allowance).

RELEVANT PRIOR LEARNING / UNITS

Y2 Autumn D&T [Textiles – Templates and joining techniques]:

- Pupils were taught to use a range of stitching and joining techniques as they created nativity-themed hand puppets using felt.
- Pupils used a simple paper pattern when creating the shape of their puppet.
- Pupils used a range of finishing techniques e.g. sewing buttons, gluing sequins, etc.

Pupils have experience of the design, make, evaluate process from all previous D&T units.
